International Seafarers Ministry, North Charleston, SC October-December 2022

153 ships were visited. 108 New Testaments/Bibles were given away in 66 languages. We gave away 153 travel kits, 19 big bottles of shampoo, and some socks. We also gave away the first 11,693 Christmas caps for this Christmas season to the sailors, the cruise ship crew, the pilots, dock workers, shipyard workers, and various terminal and security workers. There are likely at least 3000 left to give away in January. We encountered sailors from the 71 nations colored in on the map. These include 1 new nationality: Zambia. This brings a total number of nationalities encountered this year to 88 and the number encountered since 2007 to 135 out of the 195 recognized by the UN. That's 9 out of every 13 in the world.


