
ATTENTION ALL SENIORS:

Trent's Two Cents:

This Sunday, April 21st, we will nominate deacons for the coming church year. Our deacon election will be Sunday, April 28th. The Bible doesn't provide a lot of information about the specific roles of deacons within the church. However, it is clear deacons should be servant leaders in the congregation who lead by example, as they meet needs, support ministries, and protect and promote the unity of the church (Acts 6:1-6). Scripture gives more attention to the qualifications of deacons than the job description of deacons. The qualifications of deacons are listed in 1 Timothy 3:8-13. These qualifications are not based on abilities and talents, but on character and spiritual maturity. It's noteworthy that Scripture spends significantly more time describing what a deacon must be rather than what a deacon must do. This shows that God cares more about our character than our abilities. We have been blessed with many Godly servant leaders here at Washington. Please read the biblical qualifications for deacons and prayerfully prepare to write down four names for the deacon nominations this Sunday.

The Lauchpad Church (Acts 6, Jude 20-23)

What would you say is the relationship of the church to the Christian life? I'm sure this is a question to which you would get an almost unlimited number of answers. Out of all the answers that we could give, let's turn to God's Word for its own answer. Throughout Scripture, we are reminded of the power and effectiveness of God's Word to transform hearts and lives. Paul, in one of his letters to Timothy, says that the gospel is effective for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness so that one might serve God. Christ Himself says to seek first the Kingdom of God and that faith is a matter of the heart, soul, and spirit. All of this gives us a picture of the Christian life a life that is lived so as to know Christ, to grow in Christ, and to go for Christ. This is a life that moves past the elementary things of Scripture and seeks to know God in His fullness with a desire every day to be dedicating everything about ourselves to knowing Him and finding opportunities to share Him with others. If any of these things is neglected, then we are neglecting His call for our life. What all this points to is the fact that the Christian is the instrument by which God moves. So what, then, is the church but the equipping ground of the Christian? It should be a place where we learn and are challenged so that when we leave we go to our mission fields to share God's Word with the world around us. In Acts 6, we are given the example of the early church, who prioritized the preaching of the gospel knowing that it is the Gospel that will transform and train Christians to go out into the community and win others for Christ. And this is exactly what Jude commends us to do as Christians - to build up our faith, to pray, to love as God loved us and share God's Word with others around us - all in the hope that Christ has given us when He will complete our salvation at His coming!
