Seven days from now, on June 11th, we'll be celebrating our third annual **Western Night**—a fun evening of food, fellowship, and a chance to give to a Gospel cause that's dear to our hearts. This year, once again, we are raising funds for **Lemhi River Cowboy Church in Tendoy, Idaho.**

If you pull it up on a map, Tendoy is tucked away in what many call **Big Sky Country**—one of the most beautiful, rugged, and spiritually underserved areas of our nation. I've always loved that part of the country for its wide-open landscapes and pioneering spirit. But beyond its beauty, it's a place where churches are few and far between.

Near Tendoy, there are just a handful of Bible-preaching churches. Two are in the town of Salmon—about twenty minutes away—where **Pastor Mike Palmer**, who also leads Lemhi River Cowboy Church, pastors **Salmon Valley Baptist Church.** Beyond that, the next closest church is over an hour and a half away. This reminds us: we don't always have to cross oceans to find people who need the Gospel—sometimes we just have to cross state lines.

The people in the Lemhi Valley are searching for hope, and that's why I'm so excited we get to be part of supporting LRCC. Their work reminds me of the Apostle Paul's appeal when he was raising support for the church in Jerusalem:

"Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." —2 Corinthians 9:7

Paul also reminded the Corinthians of their ongoing responsibility to support Gospel ministry (see 1 Corinthians 16:2 and 2 Corinthians 9:5). As we give, Scripture promises that God will bless us—not always in material ways, but in ways that strengthen our faith and knit us together in His mission. We've seen God's faithfulness time and again here at Washington, and this is another opportunity to respond with thankful, generous hearts. So come out next week for Western Night! Bring a dessert, enjoy the fellowship, and most importantly—come ready to give as the Lord leads. Let's share the blessings we've received with the people of the Lemhi Valley.
