Babylon & Beyond: The Sovereignty of God in the Book of Daniel (1:1-4)

The first observation we make in the book of Daniel is the knowledge that none of this book is an accident, but that the fall of Jerusalem to Nebuchadnezzar and the exile of God's people was something that God Himself had designed. History tells us that Daniel was likely among the most qualified to be taken to Babylon, as conquering kingdoms often took royalty, nobility, and the most promising individuals from the nations they conquered. God's plans, however, were different. God wanted to plant Daniel in a place where His Gospel could spread to every corner of the earth, and He accomplishes that

Take a moment today and contemplate this truth: there are no accidents in your life, but only plans created by an Almighty God to make you more like Christ. To the unbeliever, all of life is just accidents, but God's people realize that in Him there are no accidents. God places us where He needs us, when He needs us, and why He needs us - not because we are capable, but because He wants to work through us in that place for a particular purpose.

And yet, we so often lament, question, or doubt our circumstances as if the God of all creation Who sent His only Son to die for our sin didn't know we would be going through the path we currently walk. So look to Christ on the cross, and know that if He can bear your sin before the face of God Almighty for forgiveness then we can walk alongside Him through life. Take heart, brothers and sisters, for He will never leave us nor forsake us (Hebrews 13:5) and in Him is the "Yes" and "Amen" to all His promises to us through Christ (II Corinthians 1:20)! Praise be to our God Who sovereignly planned all things for us and walks with us!

On August 10th, I hope you are able to join us for our Annual Ministry Fair at 6pm in the Fellowship Hall! This event is for everyone to get connected on what our church is doing and the ministries we support and where you find a ministry to serve in!
